Levamped LEAGUE STRUCTURE

- NEW Regional League North and South teams (previously city-wide) - Dependent on registration and ice availability
 - Weekday ice times regional location
 - Weekend ice times central location
 - An effort will be made to place players on teams who live in similar areas
- **NEW** Game to Skills Development Practice ratio of 2 to 1
- Approximately 36 ice times
 - **NEW** 24 Games (previously 30) (inc. tournaments mentioned above)
 - NEW 12 Skills Development Practices (previously 6)
 - **NEW** Practices run by coaches
 - Progressive development sessions focusing on individual skill development and game awareness
- --- **NEW** RHC Player Development Team
 - -- Practice Plans
 - Support coaches on ice as needed
- --- Set Days of the Week
 - Tuesdays and Saturdays

GAME PLAY

- Formally structured, three 15-minute periods, with a stop clock
- Qualified referees
- Hockey Canada Playing Rules guidelines
- No floods Players do not leave ice between periods
- Participation in Esso Minor Hockey and RHC U13 Year End Tournament
- Teams are not permitted to play in games or tournaments outside of the program or purchase ice for additional practices
