4.0 Presidents Report – Robin Latajka

• Operations council update:

- Season is off to a good start
- Experiencing some challenges getting officials (referees) for games. There is a shortage city-wide due to a lack of new officials last season (covid restrictions impacted referee clinics).
 - Still a number of challenges with the HCR 3.0 with getting people registered/transfers
 - You can expect to see a lot of 2 man assignments to games
- Game & Conduct there have been 2 major dressing room incidents already this season. Reminder to associations to follow G&C protocol. Dressing room issues are to be dealt with by the associations, not Hockey Calgary
 - > 2 person supervision rule in dressing room must be followed
 - No phones in dressing rooms

- Coaches are needed for the "First Shift" program. Reach out to Jamie Henry if you have coaches that are interested.
- Affiliates be patient. Affiliates won't be released until the end of October. Reminder that the 'Substitute Goaltender Rule' cannot be used to sit a back up goalie for a game. The rule can only be used in a true goalie shortage situation.
- COVID communication New procedures that applies to U7 to U11. All COVID communications continue to go through Erin & Corey
- Rink policies managers are expected to communicate rink policies to their teams when attending a game. Be sure managers are up to date on current rink policies.

Some rinks have started to ask for ID from 12-17 year olds ACTION: Charene to communicate with Age Group Coordinators that they are to make managers aware of this task.

- Lisa Mcgregor from the YMCA will be replacing Beth Long in her role at Hockey Calgary.
- Evaluations Huge thanks to all the Board Members who helped out during evaluations
 - KHC saw low number of withdrawals and complaints after player placement
 - Thank you to Lisa & Bruce for all the hours they put in during evaluations
 - > Thanks to Corey for stepping up to coach a team this season
- Brown Bagging for Kids very successful! Teams did a great job.

5.0 Administrator/Registrar Report – Erin Boulet

- HCR 3.0/Rostering
 - Knights experienced a technical issue with the TeamSnap roster connector
 - Teams could not upload into HCR
 - Manually entered all players and coaches into their team rosters in HCR
 - Once teams are all rostered, each team will receive a copy of their official pending Hockey Canada roster.
 - Teams will be asked to confirm their coaches
 - Once coaches are rostered, we will start working through each team to ensure that they meet the team qualification/coach certification requirements.
- Affiliates
 - > Still waiting for elite associations to finish their affiliation requests
 - Once that is complete, we will receive the affiliation request form from Hockey Calgary

- > Affiliates are expected to be approved by the end of October
- Final registration numbers for the 21/22 season
 - ➢ 57 teams
 - 956 players
 - Congratulations to Kari who guessed closest to final numbers!

6.0 Off Ice Consultant/Ice Scheduler Report – Lisa Rosier

- Off ice/Ice scheduler update
 - > This weekend is team pictures
 - Will be on both Saturday and Sunday
 - Held at Midsun Community Centre.
 - Hockey Calgary board (rink divider) training has been booked in partnership with Southwest Hockey
 - Teaches U9 and U7 coaches how to use the rink dividers
 Seeding round game scheduling started last week and was completed over Thanksgiving weekend.
 - Game schedule will be posted tomorrow
 - Will take a few days to put together the practice schedule
 - > U9, U11, U13 & U15 manager meetings have been booked
 - Jerseys have been handed out for all teams
 - Jersey care document will be posted on website
 - U9 's have all received their goalie gear
 - Teams have been instructed on how to wash jerseys
 - Jersey bond is in place for all age groups if jerseys are not returned in good condition
 - Ice is booked for Joust in the South Tournament
 - 34 teams submitted a request to host
 - Will be held Nov 26-28 and Dec 3-5
 - 4 Jousts in total
 - 2 of the 4 KHC teams already have their tournaments filled

7.0 Vice President On Ice Report – Bruce Swan

• Evaluations:

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- Less than 10 complaints
- Head coaches have been assigned for every team
- Coaches meeting is scheduled for Thursday night
- Idea to host a "Coach Them" demo
 - Everyone did a great job and evaluations ran very well!
 - Experienced a shortage of evaluation volunteers
 - Ended up having to hire evaluators
 - Will need to consider this for future evaluations
- Getting lots of questions about affiliates
 - Will remind coaches at coach meetings that you can not play anyone that is not on your roster
- Coach certifications
 - Need to review coaches that have PIC's and RIS-AL expiring
- Hosting U18 provincials?
 - Bid is due by Dec 15 if we decide to bid to host
 - Bruce will check with the U18 BC 1 team to see if there may be interest

Lisa will check with CBHA to see if this is the year that they are required to host play offs. KHC could not host provincials if CBHA is hosting playoffs this season

8.0 Vice President Off Ice Report – Kari Schwab

- Thanks to volunteers, Age Group Coordinators and helpers during evaluations
 - Had very few shifts that were not filled
 - Charene is starting to put together some feedback regarding how things went this year
- Showcases have been updated both at Cardel and Lake Bonavista arenas
 - Some products from Play it Again Sports are displayed
 - Will be adding some signage when it arrives
- Community company sponsorship/engagement
 - Companies are apprehensive about sponsoring as they are still recovering from COVID setbacks

9.0 Vice President Finance Report – Chris Willoughby

- Discount program:
 - Charene put together the idea to approach business owners within the Knights/community about offering a discount/perk to the Knights membership
 - Purpose is 2 fold: 1) offer Knights members a discount and 2) promote Knights owned businesses
 - Would need to form a subcommittee to establish guidelines for discount program and determine what information is provided to members
 - Will need to survey business owners/membership to gauge interest
 - Could be an annual program to support local business
 - Businesses would also be given the opportunity to donate to the uKnighted fund
 - KHC social media would be used to promote businesses who are participating
 - Discussing regarding using KHC membership list to promote businesses/solicitation
 - > Question regarding who would spearhead committee

ACTION: Charene to write up program idea/outline to distribute to the Board of Directors for review.

- Auditor:
 - > Would like to discuss going through a full audit at future meeting
 - Need a more consistent auditor for the future
- Questions came up at the managers meetings regarding how team funds that have been raised through fundraising can be spent
 - Primary question/concern was regarding spending team funds on apparel
 - Money raised using an AGLC licence can not be spent on food, apparel etc.
 - Apparel sponsorship is permitted
 - Discussion followed regarding limiting team spending to hockey related costs
 - How to monitor?

ACTION: Chris will put together a paragraph to clarify the Knights position on using team funds to purchase apparel and will circulate to members of the board

• Maximum cash call: Do we have one? Do we need one?

- Suggestion to institute a cash call maximum of \$250. If teams need a higher cash call limit they can request that through the Vice President Finance
- uKnighted fund application deadlines:
 - Deadline for registration fee/tier 1 applications Oct 15
 - Deadline for cash call support/tier 2 applications Dec 15

10.0 Vice President Safety & Governance Report – Corey Severtson

- Low number of withdrawals due to new COVID vaccine requirements
- A few questions regarding if negative COVID tests will still be accepted after Oct 25
- Feedback from families is that they like the vaccine requirements as it adds to them feeling safe
- Cardel is considering phasing out security guards to check proof of vaccine
 May rely on associations/user groups to screen participants
- No update on the Cardel restaurant
- Cardel has implemented mandatory vaccine requirement for employees. Must be vaccinated by Nov 15
- REMINDER: It is absolutely mandatory that every dressing room is supervised by 2 adults at all times.
 - Discussion re: how to keep phones out of dressing rooms
- Former "Coaches Room" at LBCA is now a KHC office
