 - Will arrange a preferred rate with drycleaner in area for teams to take jerseys to (\$7.50) per jersey

 - Suggestion to put jersey parent requirement back as a team role.
 - Suggestion to add \$25 jersey dry cleaning fee to PAD form

- Will still run at a deficit and will need to tap into some reserves
- Kruger funds will go to uKnighted Fund
