4.0 Presidents Report – Corey Severtson

Ops Council last night:

Affiliation issues

- 1 coach with indefinite suspension for playing an ineligible player (potential of 2 game suspension)
- Have relaxed affiliation deadlines to allow for changes
- Will not be taking any affiliation changes from Thursday to Sunday

Reseeding:

- No KHC teams have been identified as teams who need to be re-seeded

Game schedule change committee:

- Corey has put Lisa's name forward to join the committee
- Recommendation to give teams an opportunity to change games for a fee

Evaluation workgroup & survey:

- Want to form a workgroup to compile what each association is doing for evaluations
 - Hoping to get some best practices for evaluations

U9:

- 11 of 12 associations voted to stay with ½ ice for U9 this season
- Recommendation is to allow U9 teams to attend full ice tournaments outside of the city at end of season
- More discussion required for next season
- Plan is for Hockey Calgary to decide prior to the end of the season.

"Extension of first shift" – Association based "try hockey" program:

- Based on Raiders program they started last season
- Would be open to all age groups
- To run Jan to March
- HC has approached Adrenalin to be supplier of beginner hockey gear package

Coach night series:

- Doing very well
- Next 2 are sold out
- Plan to open more sessions

Update on dressing room policy:

- Corey has not heard any feedback from KHC members

Neck guards:

- Ask for associations to send our reminders about wearing neck guards

Hockey Calgary ask:

- How many kids requested body contact and how many played it last season
 - o Ryan to submit

Internal suspensions:

- If internal suspensions have been issued, they must be reported to Hockey Calgary

U11 Question from Trailswest:

- What to do if there is a hybrid goalie and a full time goalie on the same team
 - KHC does 50/50 or 65/35
 - Mostly up to coach and parents to decide
 - Some hybrid goalies do want to play out more than in net

8.0 Vice President Off Ice Report – Pearl Thai

- A U15 team has started up their own Instagram
 - Questions regarding regulating etc
- Lake Bonavista has their display case complete
 - Any KHC merch/team profiles/plaques/banners etc the board wants added
 - Suggestion to add trophy with plaques with winning teams names

9.0 Vice President Finance Report – Will Chapman

- Has been approving budgets
 - About 85% approved
 - Average budget \$7500
 - Average cash call \$200
 - U15 BC 1 has exceeded recommended budget amount
 - Has asked for permission to use busses for tournaments (approx. \$5000.00)
 - Team is not unanimous in the decision to use busses for tournaments
 - $\circ~$ Discussion BOD agrees that team should not be permitted to use bus for tournament
 - 2 teams have been approved for third jerseys
 - Both are being paid by sponsors

- Some teams have not been approved because the vote was not unanimous on their team:
 - Teams have voiced that they are not happy with the approval process

10.0 Vice President Safety & Governance Report – Dale Byrne

- o 6 teams with 9 different complaints
- Will meet with on-ice team & Corey to figure out an action plan
- Thoughts on sending a note to membership reminding them what it is to be a Knight/Hockey is a privilege, not a right etc.

 - Tournaments are full for this season except for 1 post-season tournament
